II. Directors Report – Upcoming Events/Current Events

- B. County Honor Band – Feb., 1st – 3rd; County Honor Band was musically clean but slightly less than expected. Cheryl is writing letters to the Principals of every participating school acknowledging & promoting each individual music program.**
